

No stats to support HIV/Aids mortality

MORE than 30 years after President Ronald Reagan's health secretary announced that "the probable cause of acquired immune deficiency syndrome has been found, a variant of a known human cancer virus", the massive exploitation of the corrupt ideology known as HIV/Aids continues unabated.

Critical resources have been diverted away from the treatment of the underlying poverty-related causes of ill health into the pockets of academics and propagandists propounding an essentially racist construct.

Hard-won freedoms of information and dissent have suffered and the medical profession has laid the foundation in the distribution of useless cell poisons for a disaster on the scale of their previous arsenic, mercury and thalidomide scandals.
